



FACULTY PROMOTION - CAREER ADVANCEMENT SCHEME (CAS)

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To be considered for promotion the faculty member must meet the criteria set under the CAS promotion criteria by UGC in regulations on "Minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers and other academic staff in Universities & Colleges and measures for the maintenance of standards in higher education, 2018" d as amended from time to time.

The table below gives more details of the policy followed at the University for faculty promotion:
